Cabaniss Club Lambs has been in business breeding, showing and producing quality Hampshire and Shropshire sheep since the 1960s. We have been selling our sheep at auction and by private treaty for many years. Cabaniss Club Lambs is located in western Oklahoma. The sheep flock utilizes the native grasses, winter wheat, and home-grown alfalfa for sustenance. Normally, the farm can produce plenty of feed to sustain the ewe flock through the fall and winter months. The summer of 2011, however, severely tested everyone.

Western Oklahoma suffered through one of the worst droughts in history last summer. Temperatures set record highs, and rainfall was almost non-existent. There was little grass for grazing and none for hay. Purchased hay was used to get the flock through the dry summer and winter months. The weather this spring has been much more promising, but the 6-year-old ewes that lambed in the Spring 2012 were faced with an added burden of producing and raising lambs on limited rations.

The videos and pictures were taken on two very hot days in May. You can rest assured that the sheep are accurately represented. There will be no surprises when you get them home.

The sheep were shorn about two weeks before photography by a commercial sheep shearer. You are seeing them exactly as they appear every day at Cabaniss Club Lambs.

Cabaniss Club Lambs has made its reputation by producing winners at every major show in the country, including the MidWest Stud Ram Sale, Louisville, Houston, Kansas City, Arizona Nationals, Oklahoma Youth Expo, Tulsa State Fair, and the National Western in Denver. Although we are raising and selling show animals, they must still be durable, production-oriented sheep that are able to survive in the rugged western Oklahoma environment. We are confident that our sheep can perform and thrive in any management system.
